BACKGROUND

Dr Anita Baruah Sarmah College of Education is a Teachers' Training College, established in the year 2004. The College was established earlier by NERIM Educational Society in the name and style of 'NERIM Teachers' Training College'. However, the name of the college was changed to Dr Anita Baruah Sarmah College of Education in the year 2006 after the premature demise of Dr Anita Baruah Sarmah, one of the chief founders of NERIM Educational Society. Accordingly, on the recommendation of the governing body of the college the change of name was approved by Gauhati University, theaffiliating body, through its Executive Council Resolution No.2006/2/29/20 dated 21-01-2006. Further, National Council for Teacher Education also accorded its approval for changing the name of the college from 'NERIM Teachers' Training College' to 'Dr Anita Baruah Sarmah College of Education' vide its letter No.ERC/66.12.8/2006/1998.

Dr Anita Baruah Sarmahwho was a professor and a scholar of repute started her career as a lecturer in the Department of English, Gauhati University for 22 years under several esteemed designations. Dr Anita Baruah Sarmahwas associated with NERIM Educational Society since its inception and was its philosopher and guide throughout its growth and development. For a short span of time, she remained as the President of NERIM Educational Society. Dr. Anita Baruah Sarmah cherished a dream of setting up an institute of excellence in the field of Education. She treasured a vision of providing quality training to the teachers who are torch-bearers of our younger generation and thereby develop human resource in an appropriate direction.

The idea of setting up a College of Education by NERIM Educational Society was initiated by Dr Anita Baruah Sarmah. The proposal for obtaining necessary statutory recognition from NCTE, Government of India was moved as per her advice in the month of December,2003. Gauhati University has granted its affiliation to NERIM Educational Society for conducting B.Ed programme of the University vide its Executive Council Resolution No. 2006/17/176(14) dated 08-11-2006.B.Ed programme of this College is governed as per prescribed Rules and Regulations of Gauhati University.

Gauhati University has granted its affiliation to Dr Anita Baruah Sarmah College Of Education for conducting M.A (Education) programme from the session 2016.

RECOGNITION

This College Of Education is duly recognized by **National Council For Teacher Education** NCTE as NERIM Teachers' Training College (NTTC)' vide its letter No.ERC/7-58.6.8/2005/2362, dated 20-07-2005. However, the name of the college was changed to Dr Anita Baruah Sarmah College of Education, following a resolution adopted by the meeting of the Governing Body held on 01-08-2005.

PEDAGOGY AND LEARNING METHODS

The teaching methodologies consist of a judicious blend of lectures, seminars, case studies and decisions, role-plays, management games, group presentations and special lectures by eminent academicians, scholars etc. Use of modern teaching techniques, Computer aided instructions, films, Audio-Visual means, LCD and overhead projectors etc., are a common feature of the pedagogy of this college. Here, the participants are encouraged and given opportunity to involve in course work in order to bring about effectiveness in the teaching cum learning process.

SPOKEN ENGLISH AND PERSONALITY DEVELOPMENT

Basic computer education is compulsory for each and every student of this college during the period of two years training. The students are given proper exposure to the use of modern educational techniques like LCD projector, overhead projector, and other audio visual aids. The students are given adequate training for acquiring sufficient knowledge on Spoken English by experts. Further, the students are provided training sessions for developing their communication skills and personality.

THE LIBRARY

Dr Anita Baruah Sarmah College of Education has a library enriched with around 4000 titles of books on the subjects related to Philosophical and Sociological Foundations of Education, Psychological Foundations of Education, Issues and Problems of Secondary Education, School Organization and School Hygiene, Contents and Methods of Teaching (English, History, Assamese, Mathematics, and Social Science) Educational Technology, Research Journal of Planning and Administration, University News, Journal on School Education Technology, Journal of Traditional Research, Journal of Human values, Etc. Besides this, the Institute's Library provides an opportunity to the students to keep abreast with the current News and Information by subscribing to a number of important Local and National newspapers and magazines. A quiet and spacious reading and learning atmosphere has been created in the library so as to encourage regular reading habits among the students.

HOSTEL FACILITIES

The college provides separate Hostel Accommodation for itsstudents (Boys and Girls).Doctor –On-Call facility is also available in the hostel premises. However, hostel accommodation is subject to the availability of seats.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

Admissions shall be made as per the prescribed Regulations of Gauhati University. The Common Entrance Test will be centrally conducted by Gauhati University. The students will be eligible to get admission in the TwoYearB.Ed course only when they get the requisite cut-off marks in the Common Entrance Test as per Gauhati University guidelines.

ELIGIBLITY

A candidateeligible for admission into the B.Ed program offered by Gauhati University shall be required to possess minimum 50% marks in aggregate either in Graduation or Post-Graduation in any stream from Gauhati University or any other recognized University. There is a relaxation of 5% marks for the candidates belonging to ST/SC/OBC and MOBC.

ADMISSION SCHEDULE

Issue of Admission Forms& Prospectus: June/July

Date of Admission : As per notification by Gauhati University

Commencement of Classes : As per notification by Gauhati University

FEE STRUCTURE

The admission fee shall be notified from time to time. However, admission fee/ tuition fee and other statutory fee shall be notified by the college authority and the copy of such notification shall be provided to the candidate at the time of admission.

The College authority may relax the fees to the needy students if and when necessary. Scholarships may also be awarded from time to time to meritorious students who do not have the means. The rate of such scholarships shall be determined by the college authority. Further, the students shall have to bear the Registration fee, Examination fee and other admissible fee payable to the University from time to time. Hostel fee shall be separately charged.

REGISTRATION AND MIGRATION

Candidates, who are migrating from other Universities, have to register themselves under Gauhati University. For such registration, students from any recognized University other than Gauhati University have to produce Migration Certificates within one month of admission. In case of failure to produce such Migration Certificates from their last University, students shall not be allowed to appear in the final B.Ed Examination.

SESSIONAL AND TEST EXAMINATIONS

There shall be regular Sessional & Test examinations, conducted by the College. The attendance in such Sessional & Test examinations is compulsory. Internal marks will be based on Sessional & Test examinations.

ATTENDANCE

A student registered for B.Ed programme of Gauhati University is required to have a minimum of 75% attendance of the total lectures delivered in each paper. As per regulations of Gauhati University, the student who fails to attend 75% of classes in aggregate attendance of all papers shall be declared as dis-collegiate and shall not be eligible to appear in the final B.Ed examination.

THE REGULATIONS FOR BACHELOR OF EDUCATION, B.Ed

(As prescribed by Gauhati University)

- 1. The structure of the present syllabus is relevant to face to face and regular mode of education.
- 2.A candidate may be allowed to appear in the Bachelor Of Education (B.Ed) examination provided that after passing B.A/B.Sc/B.Com or M.A/M.Sc/M.Com. Examination of Gauhati University or any other recognized University, with at least 50% (45% for SC/ST/OBC) marks, recognized for this purpose, he/she has prosecuted for not less than two years regular course of study in the subjects offered by him/her in this college for this purpose and has in addition undergone a course of practical training as indicated below.
- 3. Every candidate shall be examined in the following subjects.

^{5.} Rules of examination results.

i. Marks of external & internal examination will not be shown separately.

ii. A candidate, in order to pass must obtain at least 40% marks in aggregate i.e. a total of 560 marks out of 1400 marks.

iii. A Candidate will have to secure at least 40% marks in individual paper.

- iv. A Candidate who scores below 40% in one individual paper but if he/she secures aggregate 40% will be allowed to reappear in the examination as a back paper. (Maximum two back papers will be allowed)
- v. Candidates securing at least 840 or 60% marks shall be declared to have obtained a First Class.
- vi.Candidates securing marks between 560 to 839 (both inclusive) shall be declared to have obtained a Second Class.
- vii.A candidate who fails to pass or present himself for the B.Ed Examination shall not be entitled to claim are fund of the examination fee nor will such feebe carried over for subsequent examination.

viii.If a student after completion of a regular B.Ed course and after having obtained his/her admit card does not appear in the B.Ed Final examination for some unavoidable reason, he/she may appear in the next subsequent examination as a non-collegiate and will be required to pay the prescribed fees.

ix. If a candidate

a.Fails in theory part onlyb.Fails in practical part onlyc.Fails to secure pass marks in assignment paper(s).

but otherwise eligible(i.e. 40% out of 1400) to pass the B.Ed Examination, will be given a chance to re-appear or submit the report within two years to clear his/her paper(s)/ practicals/report/assignment. But the candidate must take casual admission(s) for the year(s) and pay all the prescribed fees for the subsequent examination(s). If a candidate fails in only one theory paper in the third year from the year of his/her admission he/ she shall have a chance to re-appear in that paper only in the immediate next year. Results of all such candidates will be declared as per clause5(ii),5(v) and 5(vi).

ADMISSION OF UNSUCCESSFUL AND ABSENT CANDIDATES.

- i. (a).Candidates who fail to pass or appear for the B.Ed final examination shall not be entitled to claim any refund of the fee nor will such fee be carried over for the subsequent examination.
- (b).If a student after completion of regular course of study for the B.Ed examination does not register himself/ herself as candidate for or present himself/herself at the examination succeeding search completion, he/she may appear at next examination as a regular candidate, provided he/she has attended the percentage of lectures required to be a regular candidate. For any subsequent examination he /she will be treated as non- collegiate and will be required to pay the prescribed non- collegiate fee.
